#### REWOLDT PROFESSOR OF MEDICINE, MAYO CLINIC

Victor M. Montori, MD is the Robert H. and Susan M. Rewoldt Professor of Medicine at Mayo Clinic. He is also a 2024-25 Human Rights and Technology Fellow at the Harvard Kennedy School of Government. An endocrinologist, health services researcher, and care activist, Dr. Montori is the author of more than 780 peer-reviewed publications and is among the most cited researchers in clinical medicine and in social science. He is a recognized expert in evidence-based medicine, shared decision making, and minimally disruptive medicine. He works in Rochester, Minnesota, at Mayo Clinic's KER Unit, to advance person-centered care for patients with diabetes and other chronic conditions. He is the author of the book Why We Revolt, and is leading a movement, the Patient Revolution, for careful and kind care for all.


