

11. Apply principles of risk assessment and evidence evaluation to public health and environmental health issues affecting patient and population outcomes.
12. Assess the scientific, legal, and political factors influencing community-level public health interventions.
13. Recognize how social, economic, and structural factors affect access to care, legal protections, and health outcomes.
14. Analyze medicolegal issues in end-of-life care, including capacity determination, surrogate decision-making, and medical futility.
15. Describe international humanitarian and military legal protections for healthcare delivery during armed conflict and their practical limitations.
16. Identify sources of information asymmetry between patients and healthcare institutions and assess their impact on transparency and accountability.
17. Evaluate legal standards governing medical and scientific evidence, including expert testimony and admissibility requirements.
18. Analyze how courts interpret complex medical, scientific, and public health evidence in emerging technology and AI-related cases.
19. Assess the impact of reproductive health law developments on clinical practice, emergency care, workforce trends, and patient access.
20. Describe regulatory requirements and risk-management considerations specific to dental and oral healthcare practice.
21. Apply legal risk-management principles to healthcare transactions, professional transitions, and continuity-of-care obligations.
22. Evaluate the legal and ethical dimensions of medical error disclosure, apology protections, and malpractice reform.
23. Analyze the effects of regulatory variability across jurisdictions on clinician behavior, healthcare markets, and patient trust.
24. Assess the balance between patient autonomy, professional judgment, and governmental oversight in healthcare decision-making.
25. Integrate legal, ethical, scientific, and policy considerations to inform compliant and patient-centered healthcare practice.




